Participation on additional days is subject to availability.</li> <li>A \$25.00 fee will be applied for all returned checks.</li> <li>If the child is dropped off before the designated drop-off time or picked up after the designated pick-up time, a charge of \$20.00 per hour or portion of any hour will be applied.
